PROVENANCE

This collection was transferred to University Archives and Special Collections in the Joseph P. Healey Library at the University of Massachusetts Boston by David Terkla in July 2013.

PROCESSING NOTES

The original arrangement and folder titles were retained in most cases. Exceptions include unlabeled folders, which were labeled by the archivist as indicated by brackets in the folder list. Personnel and student records have been removed.

HISTORICAL NOTE

UMass Boston was founded in 1964 as the urban campus of the state-wide university of the Commonwealth. Since then the University has grown to include eight separate colleges and a variety of programs, institutes and centers. The largest and oldest of these academic units is the liberal arts and sciences. In 1970-1971, the University began efforts to diversify its instructional commitment, and as part of this process, the liberal arts and sciences were divided into College I and College II. Based on Chancellor Golino's proposal and recommendation for the University's five-year plan, the colleges were reunified in 1976 by a vote from the Board of Trustees in the spring of 1976 and named the College of Arts and Sciences (CAS) with 42 major programs. In

2004, the College of Arts and Sciences was split into two separate colleges – the College of Science and Mathematics and the College of Liberal Arts.

The College of Liberal Arts offers students the opportunity to study a variety of fields in the Humanities, Social Sciences, and Fine Arts—from English to Economics, Africana Studies to Women’s and Gender Studies, Performing Arts to Psychology—as well as in interdisciplinary programs such as Asian Studies that span two or more fields of study.

More than 5,000 students—close to 50% of UMass Boston’s undergraduates—are currently working toward degrees in the twenty-six majors offered by the College’s eighteen departments. At the graduate level, the College of Liberal Arts currently offers eight Masters Programs (in American Studies, Applied Economics, Applied Linguistics, Applied Sociology, English, Historical Archeology, History, and Latin & Classical Humanities), a Master of Fine Arts in Creative Writing, and three Ph.D. Programs (in Clinical Psychology, Developmental & Brain Sciences, and Sociology).

SCOPE AND CONTENT

This collection documents the activities of the College of Arts and Sciences and the College of Liberal Arts at the University of Massachusetts Boston from 1971-2009, particularly the activities of the CAS Senate and course and program development. Records include carbon copies, photo copies, notes, reports, correspondence, memos, resumes, budgets, strategic plans, accreditation, enrollment status reports, program and regents’ reviews, self-studies, statistics, class scheduling, agenda and meeting minutes for the Faculty Council and the CLA Senate. Series I includes files that were maintained by Dean Louise Smith that date from 1971-2006. Records from Series V were probably maintained by Edna Seaman, Associate Dean from 1980-1992. Items to note include records for the Writing Proficiency Exam review by the Office of Civil Rights and Senate Actions to improve the exam from 1988-1993 and the diversification plan from 1975-1979 in Series V, Subseries iii.
